


1 Corinthians 1:10-17 • A church divided

Study 2 — Discussion Questions



- Pastor Paul reminded us there is no such thing as a perfect church and that was certainly the case in Corinth. Describe the problem in the Corinthian church that has been reported to the Apostle Paul.
- What are some things that can typically contribute to division in modern churches? What can you do personally to prevent such divisions?
- How does pride tend to contribute to a lack of agreement in church fellowships?
- Since the Apostle Paul baptized very few people, and even said, *Christ did not send me to baptize*, what implication does that have on the idea that water baptism is required for someone to be saved?
- Discuss the difference between John's baptism and Believer's baptism.
- Pastor Paul mentioned that sharing the gospel isn't as much about knowing all the facts and being eloquent, as much as simply sharing what Jesus did on the cross. How does that inspire you to share your faith?
