Study 4 — Discussion Questions

- Fancy speech was popular among the Greeks, but the Apostle Paul made a point to share the gospel with the Corinthians very plainly. In what specific ways can this be an example for us to follow as well?
- According to verse 5, what danger may exist when people are attracted by persuasive speaking alone?
- Verse 10 begins to express a contrast between two different types of people. The contrast centers around one particular spiritual element. What is it?
- If we want to *comprehend the thoughts of God*, how is that done (according to verse 11)?
- What advice does the Apostle Paul pass along to us about trying to convey spiritual insights to unbelievers?
- How would you define these terms: **carnality** and **spirituality**?
