Study Notes for 2 Peter 1 (Part 1) v1-4

- Peter identified himself as a "bond-servant" of Jesus. Describe what that means and why it is important.
- In **verse 1** Peter states that Jesus is both God and Savior. The grammar of this Greek sentence requires us to attribute the titles God and Savior to the same person. Why is this an important revelation?
- In the first 4 verses of this chapter Peter mentions several things that believers have been given. What are they?
- Peter makes two statements about our faith in verse 1. Find them and describe what he's saying.
- In **verses 2 and 3** Peter describes the benefit of having an experiential knowledge of Jesus Christ. What are the benefits that he outlines?
- What does it mean to have an experiential knowledge of someone?
- What kinds of things would you expect to see in the life of a person who is daily experiencing the presence and goodness of God?
- What things can we do to experience God more on a daily basis?
