

## Study Notes and Questions for Daniel 7

- What important background details for this chapter are given in the opening verse?
- How would you express in your own words the important details of Daniel's dream as presented in verses 2–6?
- What important details of Daniel's dream emerge in verses 7–8?
- Describe what Daniel goes on to see in his vision in verses 9–10, and convey the significance of what he observes.
- The term “Ancient of Days” (7:9, 13, 22) is a designation for God that occurs only in this chapter. What does this designation tell you about God?
- What title do you see in verses 13 that was used by Jesus to refer to Himself?
- What does verse 14 tell you about “the son of man”?
- Take a moment to read Mark 14:62 and notice how Jesus quoted Daniel 7 when answering the chief priest.
- How did Daniel react to the visions shown to him? (7:15)
- In verses 16–18, what initial interpretation of the visions does Daniel receive, and from whom?
- In verses 19–20, how does Daniel describe his further desire for understanding? What is he concerned about?
- How would you summarize the explanation for these things as given in verses 23–26?
- From what he sees and experiences in this chapter, what would you say Daniel is learning most about God?
