- What does it mean to "die to self" and why do we want to do it?
- Read verse 25 aloud. What warning does Jesus give in this verse?
- Give an example of what it means to "hate" your life?
- How is verse 25 the opposite message of the world?
- What does it mean in verse 25 to "keep" your life?
- What does verse 26 say about those who are truly servants of the Lord?
- What does it mean in verse 26 to be where Jesus is?
- In your opinion, what is the most difficult part of this study?
