

Study Notes and Questions for John 14 (Part 4) :18-31

- Why do you think Jesus felt the need to comfort His disciples?
- Jesus knew full well that He would be suffering very soon and yet He took time to comfort and give assurance to His closest followers. What does that tell you about Him?
- In **verse 18** Jesus said, “**I will come to you.**” When was that promise fulfilled?
- In **verse 19** Jesus said, “**Because I live, you also will live.**” Explain what He meant by that statement as if you were telling an unbeliever.
- **Verse 20** speaks of something Jesus said that the disciples would know. What would they know and how would they know it?
- Read **verses 25 and 26**. What role of the Holy Spirit does Jesus highlight in these verses?
- Jesus promised to give His disciples peace in **verse 27**. In the teaching we talked about peace with God through the sacrifice of Jesus and peace from knowing that God is caring for us daily. Read **Colossians 3:15**. What role does the peace of Christ play in that passage?
- In **verse 28** Jesus declared. “...**the Father is greater than I.**” How would you explain that statement to a new believer who had just heard that Jesus is God and equal to the Father?
- What title did Jesus give to Satan in **verse 30**?
- When Jesus said about Satan, “**He has no claim on me**” — what did He mean?
- What are the implications of Satan having no claim on Jesus for you as a believer?
- How should such a statement affect the way we live and pray?
- What was the most important thing you learned from this study?
