- Based on His statement, “I am the light of the world” what can you deduce about Jesus?
- What is the promise of verse 12?
- What is the condition (requirement) of the promise?
- What are the ways you personally know that Jesus has given you “the light of life”?
- What are a believer’s personal responsibilities connected to this light?
- What objection did the Jewish Religious Leaders raise in verse 13?
- How did Jesus respond to their objection? (v14-18)
- What did Jesus mean by the statement, “You judge according to the flesh”? What other ways are there to Judge?
- How often do you think believers are guilty of judging according to the flesh?
- Read what Jesus said in **verse 23**. What is the connection between that statement and what Jesus said about believers in **John 15:19**?
- What prophesy does Jesus give in **verse 28**?
- What expression of confidence in God the Father does Jesus give in **verse 29**?
- Can believers echo this same confidence?
- The Jewish Religious Leaders seemed to be determined not to believe anything Jesus said. But in **verse 30** there was a very different response by the common people. What explanation can you give for these very different responses?
- What do you believe is the most significant thing about this study and why?
- In what way should these verses affect your prayer life?
