2. Explain how that description defines the world in which we now live.
3. List a few areas where something that the Bible reveals as wrong is believed to today to be right and good.
4. Explain how Proverbs 14:12 applies to these chapters and our own world.
5. What was wrong with the solution that the Israelites came up with to save the Benjamites from extinction?
6. Take a moment to think about areas in your life where you might be tempted to compromise God's Word.
