- Why do you think the men of Succoth and Penuel refused to help Gideon?
- How could Gideon have responded differently to the issue with the men of Succoth and Penuel?
- Gideon said he didn't want to be the people's King. What actions on his part told a different story?
- Read Galatians 6:7-8 and describe how this verse applies to the story of Gideon
- Read John 3:30 and explain how John the Baptist's attitude differs from Gideon's.
