- Read **Hebrews 1:1–3** aloud. What does this passage say about God's special and final revelation of Himself?
- What are some of the first clues we get in the Scriptures that God is revealing Himself as a plurality?
- Cite at least two passages from the Bible that reveal the personhood of the Holy Spirit.
- How would you respond to someone who believed that the Bible reveals that there are three separate Gods? How does Isaiah 43:10 refute that idea?
- When we say that the nature of God is "incomprehensible" what do we mean?
- Some people will say that it is illogical and unreasonable to believe anything that is unexplainable. How would you respond to that statement?
- If mankind was entirely able to comprehend and explain the nature of God, what would that say about God? What would that also say about mankind?
