- What does it mean when it says that Jesus “was transfigured”?
- What is significant about the appearance of Moses and Elijah?
- **Note:** The Transfiguration gave the three chosen disciples a preview of the coming kingdom. Check out what Peter wrote about this event: 2 Peter 1:17–18.
- Why was God’s voice important to the Transfiguration? How would the account have been different without it?
- How did the disciples react to the voice of God?
- Why was the discussion that Jesus had with His disciples on Elijah important?
- Why were the disciples unable to drive out the demon in the boy and what does this passage teach us about our need for faith?
- What can we do to have a stronger and more robust faith?
- What lesson did Jesus teach Peter in 17:25–27?
- What principle did Jesus model by paying the Temple Tax?
- Why do you think Pastor Paul referred to this principle as one that takes maturity to accept and walk out?
- What part of this chapter resonated with you the most and why?
