- What was it about Jesus' response about paying taxes that ruined the intentions of the religious leaders?
- Why is it important to know what the Sadducees did and didn't believe as it related to the question they put to Jesus?
- Read Jesus' statement in **verse 29**. How does this statement apply to certain beliefs today?

- What question did Jesus ask?
- What point was Jesus trying to make?
- Why is it important to understand both the human and divine nature of the Son of God?
- What part of this chapter resonated the most with you personally?
