Read Romans chapter 10

Questions about the Passage:

- In what ways can we see that the Jews had a zeal for God?
- What is the difference between man's righteousness and God's?
- What does it mean that Christ is the "end of the law for righteousness"?
- Re-read Romans 10:9 What two things are necessary according to this verse to be saved?
 - Why confess?
 - Does a confession guarantee true belief?
 - What does it mean to confess Jesus "as Lord"?
- verse 19 Why did God intend to make Israel jealous?
 - o When will this occur?
 - Isn't jealousy a bad thing?
 - Why or why not?

Digging Deeper:

- What does verse 21 tell us about God's/Christ's character? Patience.
- Re-read verses 14-15. Paul doesn't answer these questions. How should they be answered?
- Paul said that Israel has zeal without knowledge. Read John 4:24
 - How does the passage in John speak to the issue of having both zeal and knowledge?
 - What would be the result of worshipping Jesus without truth?
 - How about worshipping Jesus without the Spirit.

Applying God's Word:

- What can you DO to make sure your passion for God is also attended by knowledge?
- Why do you think it's so easy for people to slip into thinking that they need to WORK to be acceptable to God?
 - What can we do to keep ourselves from that trap?
