Read Romans 8: 1-17

- Why do you think so many believers have clung to verse 1 over the years?
- What comments from Pastor Paul's teaching impacted you the most?
- What does it mean to "walk according to the Spirit"? and how can we do it?
- How does the Holy Spirit "bear witness" to you that you are a child of God?

Digging Deeper

Since the focus of this passage is all about listening to and following the Holy Spirit in our lives, let's look into that more...

- **Read John 14:15-17** What PROMISE does Jesus make in this passage concerning the Holy Spirit?
- How do you suppose the early believers felt about the Holy Spirit actually coming INSIDE THEM to take up residence?
- In what ways does the Holy Spirit convict you of sin?
- Read Galatians 5:16 What does Paul mean when he speaks of "keeping in step with the Spirit"?
- Read Galatians 6:8 What does it mean to "sow to the Spirit"?
- Read Ephesians 4:30 How do we "grieve the Holy Spirit"?

- What is the primary thing God wants us to learn from Romans 8: 1-17?
- Re-read verse 6. What things can we do to "set our minds" on the Spirit?
- How can we develop a listening ear to the voice of the Spirit?
